As we have discussed the above research as it has unfolded over the past year or two I thought I would let you know that the full report on the project is now available on the Australian Government's DEST website.

The study analysed the 280,000 comments made on the national higher education Course Experience Questionnaire from 90,000 students in 14 Australian universities. The aim was to identify directly from what students say engages and retains them in higher education across a wide range of contexts and fields of education. Also included is a detailed review of the literature on engagement and retention which might be of interest.
